

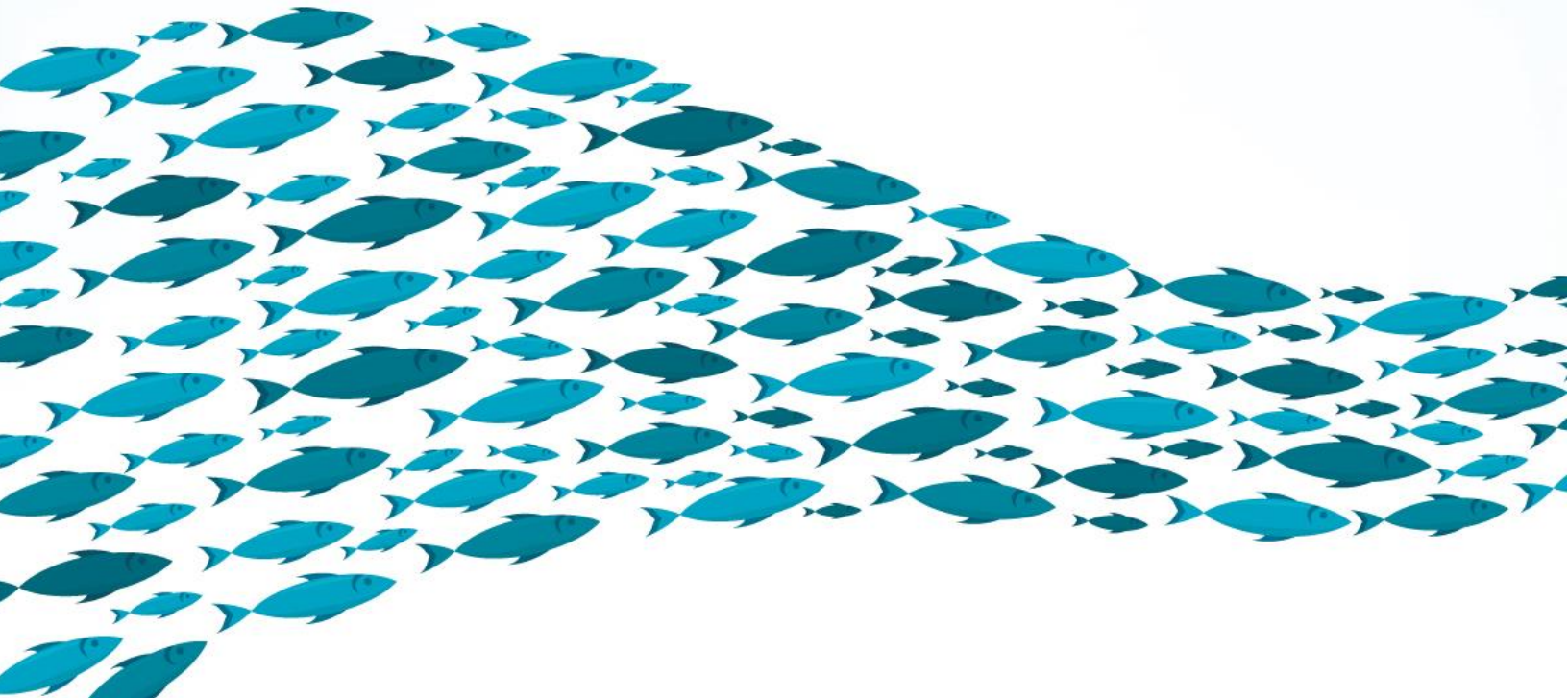

INTERIM REPORTS

1. The Committee's First Interim Report was presented in the House of Representatives on Friday December 11, 2020 and in the Senate on Tuesday December 15, 2020. Your Committee requested and was granted an extension of time to July 31, 2021 in order to complete its work.

MEETINGS

2. Since the presentation of the First Interim Report, your Committee has held one (1) meeting on Thursday June 24, 2021.
3. The Minutes of the Meeting are attached at **Appendix I**.

WORK TO DATE

4. Your Committee has invited one hundred and eleven (111) stakeholders to provide written comments on the Bill. The full list of those stakeholders is attached at **Appendix II**.
5. To date, your Committee has received twenty-six (26) submissions from the following stakeholders:-

6. Due to the volume and complexity of the Bill and the challenges under the prevailing circumstances, twenty-two (22) stakeholders requested extensions of time to complete their review of the Bill and submit comments.
7. The technocrats from the Office of the Chief Parliamentary Counsel (CPC) and Fisheries Division, Ministry of Agriculture Land and Fisheries have commenced an analysis of all the stakeholder submissions received to date.
8. During its **Third Meeting**, the Chairman directed that the technocrats from the Fisheries Division will work together with the Secretariat to identify and assist the various Stakeholders that may still require physical copies of the Bill or any assistance and support in analysing and understanding the Bill. Any stakeholders also experiencing challenges in submitting comments to the Committee would also be assisted.

REPORT

9. Your Committee wishes to report that is desirous of receiving submissions from a wider cross section of stakeholders, to ensure effective engagement with and input from the persons and entities who will be directly affected by the proposed legislation.
10. In addition, due to the complexity and voluminous nature of the Bill, your Committee will require more time to receive more stakeholder submissions and comments and to conduct a proper clause by clause review and analysis of the Bill.
11. Consequently, in accordance with Standing Orders 114(1) and 104(1) of the House of Representatives and the Senate respectively, your Committee wishes to report that due to the imminent prorogation of the First Session of the Twelfth Parliament, it is unable to complete its work. However, your Committee has made considerable progress in advancing the Committee's work schedule.

RECOMMENDATION

12. Your Committee therefore recommends the resumption of proceedings on the **Fisheries Management (No. 2) Bill, 2020** in the Second Session, Twelfth Parliament.

13. Your Committee also asks that the House take note of the extensive work completed and the progress made by the Committee thus far and that a Committee be appointed in the Second Session to continue work on the Bill and adopt as part of its records, all work completed to date.

COMMENCEMENT

- 1.1 The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 2:31 p.m.

CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE SECOND MEETING

- 2.1 The Committee examined the Minutes of the Second Meeting held on Wednesday November 25, 2020.
- 2.2 The motion for the confirmation of the Minutes of the Second Meeting was moved by Mr. Rushton Paray and seconded by Ms. Yokymma Bethelmy.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

- 3.1 Per item 5.1 the Chairman advised Members that:
- i. the Secretariat has sent out invitations to various stakeholders for comments/submissions on the Bill, in accordance with the amended list of stakeholders agreed upon by the Committee;
 - ii. to date the Secretariat has received twenty-six (26) stakeholder submissions thus far from some key stakeholders;
 - iii. twenty-two (22) requests for extensions of time to submit comments had been received; and
 - iv. extensions of time had been granted on two (2) occasions, (January 31, 2021 and March 1, 2021).
- 3.2 The Chairman advised Members that the technocrats from the Office of the Chief Parliamentary Counsel (CPC) and Fisheries Division, Ministry of Agriculture Land and Fisheries had commenced an analysis of all the submissions received in respect of clauses 1 to 71 out of the total two hundred and forty-two (242) clauses contained in the Bill. The Chairman informed that this document was available on Rotunda for Members perusal.
- 3.3 The Chairman suggested and the Committee agreed that technocrats from the Fisheries Division, Ministry of Agriculture Land and Fisheries work with the Secretariat would develop strategies for stakeholder engagement and public outreach to ensure that a wide cross-section of comments would be received.
- 3.4 It was also agreed that the Fisheries Division will also assist stakeholders that may be experiencing challenges or difficulties in submitting comments to the Committee, when the the COVID-19 Public Health Regulations have been relaxed.
