

The Regulations Committee

- (a) which involves the expenditure of public moneys or imposes or fixes fees for licenses or for services;
- (b) which cannot be challenged in the Courts on the ground that it is *ultra vires*, or is only temporarily so challengeable;
- (c) the making of which appears to constitute an unusual or unexpected use of the powers conferred by the law under which it was made;
- (d) which purports to have retroactive effect although the law under which it was made does not in terms give the Minister such a power;
- (e) the publication or the laying before the House of which, appears to have been unduly delayed;
- (f) in respect of which there has been unjustifiable delay in notifying the Speaker that the instrument had come into operation before it was laid before the House; or
- (g) the purport or form of which appears to require elucidation,



It shall be appointed by order of the Senate which shall specify the terms of reference of the Committee and shall consist of such Senators and as many Senators as may be directed by order of the Senate and, in the absence of such direction, shall consist of such Senators as may be chosen by the President."

69 (2) provides that "the quorum of a Special Select Committee shall be such as shall be specified in the order of the Senate or, in the absence of such Order, by the President."

There were four such Committees appointed for this session to address various bills.

- (D) Enterprises owned or controlled by or on behalf of the State or which received funding from the State of more than two third of its total income in any one year; and
- (E) Service Commissions, in relation to their administration, the manner of the exercise of their powers, their methods of functioning and any criteria adopted by them in the exercise of their powers and functions;

STANDING ORDERS 71B (3) and 79B (3) of the Senate and House of Representatives respectively give effect to the operations of these Committees.

These Committees are established for the life of a Parliament. Three such Committees were established for this Tenth (10th) Parliament.






This graph illustrates the number of bills brought forward and the number that lapsed at the conclusion of the Fourth Session of the Tenth Parliament in both houses.
